

EXERCISE SHEET – GRAMMAR – CONDITIONAL**PRESENT CONDITIONAL** (= 2<sup>nd</sup> Cond.) *Irréel du présent*A - Put the verbs into the correct form.

1. If I ... **knew** ..... his number, I ... **would phone** ..... him. (know/phone)
2. I ... **would buy** ..... this coat if I ..... **were** ..... you (buy/be)
3. We ..... **would need** ..... a car if we ... **lived** ..... in the country (need/live)

2. He doesn't speak very clearly. That's why people don't understand him.  
**If he spoke more clearly, people would understand him** .....
3. We don't go out very often because we can't afford it.  
**We would go out more often if we could afford it** .....
4. I have to work tomorrow evening. So, I can't meet you.  
**If I didn't have to work tomorrow evening, I would be able to meet you** .....

**PAST CONDITIONAL** (3<sup>rd</sup> conditional) *Irréel du passé*A - Put the verbs into the correct form.

1. I didn't know you were in hospital. If I **had known** .... I ... **would have gone** ..... visit you. (know / go)
2. Ken got to the station in time to catch his train. If he ... **had missed** ... it, he ... **would have been** late for his interview (miss / be)
3. It's good that you have reminded me about Ann's birthday. (forget / not remind)  
I ... **would have forgotten** ..... if you **hadn't reminded** me.

B – Write a sentence with **if** for each situation :

1. I wasn't hungry, so I didn't eat anything.  
**If I had been hungry, I would have eaten something** .....
2. I didn't know that George had to get up early, so I didn't wake him up.  
**If I had known that George had to get up early, I would have woken him up** .....
3. I was able to buy the car only because Jim lent me the money.  
**I wouldn't have been able to buy the car if Jim hadn't lent me the money** .....
4. Margaret wasn't injured in the crash because she was wearing a seat belt.  
**Margaret would have been injured in the crash if she hadn't been wearing a seat belt** .....
